JANUARY 3-12, 2026

10 days of deep immersion in the
wildest Patagonia



THE EXPEDITION

What is this expedition?

A unique and demanding experience in one of the most spectacular corners of southern Chile: the Huequi Peninsula, on the northern coast of Patagonia. This journey combines mountain trekking, fjord navigation, natural hot springs, and the ascent of Huequi Volcano, from where Patagonia unfolds in 360 degrees, along with explorations through pristine landscapes protected by UNESCO.

**This is not traditional tourism.
This is a real expedition for real adventurers.**

Who is it for?

- ▶ Active people with trekking experience and good physical condition.
- ▶ Nature lovers who enjoy effort, camaraderie, and the unpredictable
- ▶ You don't need to be an athlete, but you do need a real desire to move and fully live the adventure

Dates and duration

- ▶ **First Expedition:** January 3 to 12, 2026
- ▶ **Duration:** 10 days / 9 nights
- ▶ **Start and End:** Puerto Montt
- ▶ **Group size:** Maximum of 6 to 7 people

Mandatory requirements

- ▶ Previous experience in mountain trekking
- ▶ Good physical condition, ability to hike 6–8 hours with a backpack
- ▶ Willingness for demanding itineraries and variable weather conditions
- ▶ Ability to adapt to unforeseen events
- ▶ Team spirit

Location

- ▶ PHuequi Peninsula, Northern Patagonia
Huequi Volcano (1,318 m)
- ▶ Hornopirén, northern gateway to the Carretera Austral
- ▶ Landscapes protected by UNESCO



IN HUEQUI – 5 NIGHTS

1 Flight by light aircraft and installation

Light aircraft flight from Puerto Montt to Ayacara. Accommodation in local guesthouses. First contact with the peninsula.

2-3 Ascent to Huequi Volcano (1,318 m)

2-day expedition through wild trails with 360° panoramic views of the Andes, Chiloé Island, and Patagonian fjords. One bivouac night on the mountain under the stars, weather permitting.

4 Porcelana Geysers and Natural Hot Springs

Navigation through Comau Fjord to the Porcelana Geysers – unique geological phenomena in the area – combined with relaxation in natural Porcelana Hot Springs.

5 Ica Island – Penguins and Marine Life

Boat trip to Ica Island for penguin and marine life watching. A unique experience to connect with Patagonian wildlife in its natural habitat. Kyak if sea conditions permit

Accommodation in Huequi: Local guesthouses with breakfast and dinner included. One bivouac night on the volcano, under Patagonian stars.

6 Traslado a Hornopirén

Barge transfer to Hornopirén, the northern gateway to the Carretera Austral. Accommodation in comfortable cabins and a visit to the village.

7 Trek to Lake Cabrera

Trek to Lake Cabrera, hidden among virgin forests and mountains. A hike that takes us deep into the Valdivian rainforest, with its giant ferns and ancient Patagonian larch trees.

8 Río Blanco Waterfalls and Rafting

Hike to the Río Blanco waterfalls and rafting descent. A refreshing experience combining the contemplation of spectacular waterfalls with the adrenaline of rafting.





EN HORNOPIRÉN - 4 NOCHES

Trek to Lake General Pinto Concha

Trek with views of the Hornopirén Volcano, a crystal-clear mirror of water surrounded by ancient forests, where only the wind in the treetops breaks the silence.

Return to Puerto Montt

Bus return to Puerto Montt. Time to process the experience and say goodbye to the group, now a small family after 10 intense days.

Accommodation in Hornopirén: Comfortable cabins with breakfast included. Free dinner in the village to explore local options.



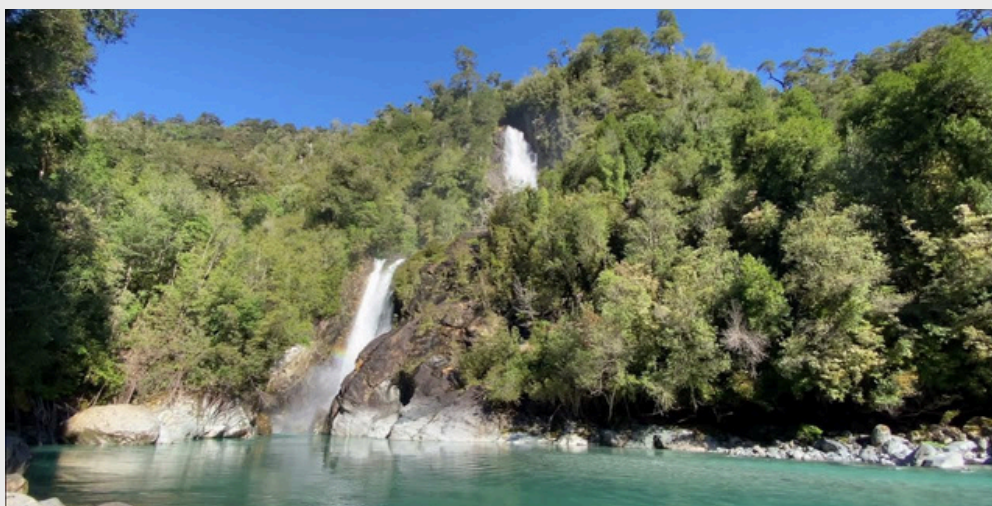
